

## **Silver Firs II Annual Board Meeting Minutes**

Meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m. by Tom Gish.

The notice of the annual meeting was mailed out timely. A Quorum was not established.

Introductions were made of those in attendance.

Homeowner Q & A:

Topics included discussion of seeking landscaping/tree replacement bids in the Spring, potential speed bump installation in selected locations, rule violations and site inspections, and signage by mailbox stations.

A brief description of each Committee function was made and it was asked for volunteers to fill vacancies in the various committees that are currently inactive (communications, operations, landscape and finance). Currently the board and / or management have been handling those functions. The ACC is currently active.

Tom answered questions regarding the 2017 budget and profit and loss statement and answered homeowner questions. The Budget for 2017 was ratified and there will be no dues increase in 2017. Payment coupons will be mailed out in late December. The annual fee for 2017 is \$315.00. A \$25.00 discount will be given to those that pay their dues by January 31, 2016.

With a quorum not being achieved the Board will appoint new Board members and there was one owner present that expressed interest in being on the Board and they will likely attend the next board meeting to meet determine their interest and availability.
